# FACULTY

The Study Tour will be in charge of Dr. Theora England, Professor of Speech and Drama at Northwestern College since 1941. Dr. England traveled in Europe in 1960 with the religious Drama Interest Group from Union Theological Seminary. She has conducted numerous successful drama tours with college students in the United States and Canada. In 1967, Dr. England conducted a successful "Festivals of Europe" study tour for Northwestern College.
