We have had a very busy week here again they suddenly decided that we should do Battery unk in the morning and our orderly work in the afternoon So that heeps us putly busy. Also this week our Battalin had to quard the camp so we (every body) had to do quardeduty for 2 days 13 night, like had our first quard on tuesday night and wednesday. Mussfairly nice weather up till midnight and then a to mile anhow gate hit the camp and in 15 minutes the thermometer dropped 30° and buenets of water standing around for fire prevention toen flozen solid. You ean undgene how much fun it was to walk with a gen blooded) on your should in such weather from 3-5 AM, Some of the fellows suffered frost-bute but I managed to keep up a lettle derculation by beating my hands and fut On thursday we were out in the full all day so we had to take some more of that cold weather. On Friday we went back again on quand, but I had a nice post to walk and et was quite a little warmen, so that wasn't so bad. We got off quard duty last night at about 5 PM. after getting cleaned up we went to town and had our denne in a Hotel. Steat. 80 cent

but it was worth it send our filed food here lately has been mostly slum and nothing appetring either. This morning I attended church server atour own regimental Chapil. There were only a few there but nevertheless we had a pice service. Our Chaplain is a very young fellow and neally nise.
