Gideon LeCocq Fatally Stricken Sunday

Gideon M. LeCocq, Everett attorney, collapsed on a street in Seattle's University District Sunday night and was dead on arrival at a hospital, according to the Associated Press.

Mr. LeCocq, who came here from Edmonds in the mid-twenties is survived by a daughter, Mary, at the University of Washington, and three brothers, Drs. Edwin and John Le Cocq of Seattle and Frank of Lake Stevens and Riverside, Calif.

Gideon M. LeCocq of Seattle died suddenly in Seattle Sunday. Mr. LeCocq was born at Harrison, S.D., November 18, 1890. He was graduated from the University of South Dakota and obtained his law degree at the University of Michigan. He was a practicing attorney in Everett for over 30 years. He leaves one son, Frank G. LeCocq of the Highlands in Seattle; two daughters, Mrs. Robert Dyer, 927 Colby Avenue, and Mrs. John Post of Los Angeles; five brothers, Dr. John LeCocq and Dr. Edward LeCocq of Seattle, Frank LeCocq of Riverside, Calif., and Irwin and Ralph LeCocq of Lynden, and one grandson. Private funeral services were held at the Chapel of Challacombe and Fickel at 3 o'clock this, Wednesday, afternoon. The Rev. M. M. Stocker of First Presbyterian Church, of which Mr. LeCocq was a member, officiated. Cremation and inurnment followed at View Crest Abbey.
