Dear Folks;

It is nearly eleven o'clock already and as yet I haven't written any letters. All evening I have put it off while I cleaned up my room and listened to the radio, but now I have to hurry if I'm going to write my usual number of letters on Sunday.

All our snow is gone from up here now again but it remains very wet. Occasionally when it clears up for a few hours we can see the snow on Mt Ranier. Next month we will see plenty of it when

we go back to Yakima.
Am glad to hear you have
three of my bonds. Does it
state on the Bonds that that
they were bought in the months
of June July, & August respectively?
Let me know if you get one for
each month starting with June.
Altogether I should have 8
counting the one I just bought
this last January.

I just received my check for
January. Since I received the
extra \$50. for a clothing allowance
on this check it was fairly
large - in fact the biggest
check I ever got it was \$252.95.
Of course a bond and room rent
had been deducted already so
originally it was over \$300.

Starting this week we
are having these alerts again
when we pack all our things
and move out for a day or
two. It makes it pretty busy
packing and unpacking.

Must close now and write
a few more letters. Hope
you are all well as I
am —
