Dear Folks;

Just a few words to let you know when we arrived here in Rolla. As you know we left Cedar Rapids on Saturday evening shortly after eleven o'clock on the streamliner "the Rocket" and got into St. Louis around eight yesterday morning. Connections were very good since we stepped off one train and on to the next which left at eight-thirty bringing us into Rolla at eleven-thirty - so it only took 12 hours from Cedar Rapids which is very good time. The trains were not too crowded so we managed to get seats.

We were both quite tired when
~~we~~ we got into Rolla so we did
a lot of sleeping yesterday afternoon
and last night.

At present we are staying here in
the Hotel - Genevieve is going to try to
get rooms some other place - says it
will give her something to do while
I'm away at camp.

I'm going back to camp either this
afternoon or tonight since I am to
report back in today.

We had a good-time over at
Ted and Jennie's even though it did
rain there all day.
