Germany
Dear Dad, Mother & Bob,

Sorry I haven't been able to write for several days but we have been kept quite busy so I didn't get to write any letters for about a week.

At present we are enjoying some pretty nice weather, in fact it is just like spring.

Personally I am feeling just fine but am a little tired. My eyes have been giving me a little trouble but nothing serious.

I didn't get to see Budd Thomson either. I tried to see him one morning but missed him by a couple of hours. Now we are quite away apart again.

Today I received some mail that

was mailed last Dec 1st - Christmas
Cards and three letters from my wife.
The boat there were on ran into
a lot of difficulty so the mail was
really delayed.

I am enclosing a picture which
was taken last August at La Ferté
Macé France - Right after we "captured"
the Germans in the "Italian Pocket"
It is a picture of the Officers of our
outfit and was taken just prior
to the time we chased the Germans
up to Aachen.

Well I must close now - hope
you are all well, are the roads
very bad this spring on the route?
