THREE BROTHERS L'COCCQ IN SERVICE

JOHN LeCOCQ, BROTHER CITY ENGINEER, SERIOUSLY ILL, PNEUMONIA AT CAMP KEARNEY

Frank LeCocq, city engineer, received word today that his brother, John, who has been dangerously ill with pneumonia at Camp Kearney, was improved. John LeCocq enlisted from the University of Washington, where he was studying medicine, and is stationed in the medical corps at the base hospital at Camp Kearney.
