Of course services user out of the question butas think back to what should have been Easter Lehow d wit faget it for on Easter night I passed through enemy lines ture and got as far as four miles behind their lines. Welmade it back hear with lettle troubles these last few day I have seen an almost endless line of liberated Poles, Jusseans, French Belgian Stalian and Dutch slave laborers along the roads. All of them in their sitisful clothes and with all their worldly premins

Column backs ploolding year - beck to their home. From them we get glad smiles and joyous hand having but to the Germano we are the appressor. An our rapid advance of course there are many of the energy left behind. Consequently every when we go we are checking people for their papers to see if they are civilians a soldiers in civilian clothes.
