Rode on two streamlines for Omaha to Kansas City, Mo. and from Kansos they to Oklahoma City. Idad a 5h layare in Kansas lity from 12-5:30. Arnord in Fat Worth at 7 A.M. This morning and couldn't get a train centel 11:15 P.m. for Brainwood as I tock a Bus for 2 and got into Dramord at 11:15 this morning.
