UNITED STATES ARMY CAMP BOWIE, TEXAS June 14/942 Ha Blu 1st Bn 1/7th field Artillery Cear folks; Its Sunday evening and time for my weekly letter home. Needless to say I'm back in the grown again, working like befor — it doesn't hardly seem like I've been home at all I thought I was writing you some real news when I wrote that I had a new rating and raise in pay, but the fellow told me they sent me a cond and that must have gotten there on Monday so you knew all about it before even I did, I didn't go out to the field on either tuesday or Wednesday, all I did was just catch up on a little filing of wands that had accumulated during my absence and also eatch up on plenty of sleep. On Wednesday night I was Soft of the

Guard. Since there is a great amount of formality of in quard mount I was a little shakefin calling out the Commands and marching the quand in Review; but I got along o.k. That 3 cplo 24 Poto and Il presmers under me but had no trouble. Had to Inspect the Sentry's on Post a couple of times during the high In the day time I had to detail several Griands as Prison Chasers and they had to watch Over the Susoners while they worked. Thursday evening I got off guard at about 7.30 P.M. and then we had to go to the field and join the Bly. at 9:30 pm we moved to a new Position und blackout when we arrived at 11 p.m. then we could start beginning to Compute a survey. During the day one of the men on the Survey Crew gota slight case of sunstake I Thursday and Friday it was blesleving hat here (much hotte than Lower has in mid-summer). at 2A.M. we

UNITED STATES ARMY finished on the Survey and then we got an hours sleep, at 3 AM. we were back again working out some 30 defferent fire commande Since it didn't cool off at all during the might we just stayed wringing weld sural. The Cheggers are just territe - I'm letterally covered with bites and they really drive you muts since they itch so much worse than morgante bets We came back into camp again Kriday evening. Saturday noon at dinner time I was a bad boy. You see we have a ruling here that we must wear Khahi for Saturday denness, well I saw some of the fellows go in to denner dressed in fatigue los I did too Well as a punishment the B.C. gave me Idays restriction to the Bly and - so all day to day I haven been able to leave this area even to go to choul So I wally got plenty Isley again today.

Soot night I went down town and I'm sending you folks a greant you can consider it a Mother Day of thethers Day Ruser A hega you like it. Lalso got payed gesterday, it gust happened the BC held my may for me. Well I must close now, here hoping you are allwell, I must gape.
